# Vaccine Information



The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) is strengthening its recommendation on COVID-19 vaccine booster doses. Everyone age 18+ who is fully vaccinated against COVID-19 should receive a COVID-19 booster vaccine.

## When Should You Receive a Booster Vaccine?

- If you previously received the Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna vaccine, you should get a booster dose **6 months** after completing your two dose vaccination series.
- If you received the Johnson & Johnson's Janssen, you should get a booster dose **2 months** after receiving the single dose vaccine.
- CDC recommendations now allow for mix and matching of booster shots, allowing you to receive any of the COVID-19 vaccines authorized in the United States.
- If you have not yet received a vaccine, now is the time!



## COVID-19 Vaccine Reminders

- Everyone 5 years & older is now eligible to receive the vaccine
- COVID-19 vaccines are safe and effective
- COVID-19 vaccines are free
- COVID-19 vaccines protect you, your family, and your community from severe illness
